Mr. Majed Aljudaibi is employed as a trainee in trauma and orthopaedic surgery from the 6th of June January 2007 expected the 31st of Marc 2012 at the Department of Trauma and Orthopaedics of the Berufsgenossenschaftliches Unfallkrankenhaus Hamburg (BG Trauma Center Hamburg). The Trauma Hospital is a Level 1 trauma center and acts as a tertial referral center for the north-west of Germany. It includes Departments of Neurosurgery and Neurology, Plastic and Hand Surgery, a large Burns Unit, a large Intensive Care Unit, one of the largest Spinal Units in Germany as well as a 170 bed Department of Trauma and Orthopaedic Surgery.

During this period Mr. Majed Aljudaibi was working in the aseptic department of acute trauma and elective orthopaedics.

After a period of only 3 months Mr. Majed Aljudaibi was able to work on the ward as a registrar in training. This included taking of medical histories and clinical examination, discharge reports and the general medical ward work. He participated in the weekly ward rounds, the weekly teaching day and the daily radiology meetings. He had the opportunity to develop the skills to examine and diagnose radiographs of the musculoskeletal system which he used to our fullest satisfaction. In the operating theatre Mr. Majed Aljudaibi is involved in a large number of procedures, first as a first assistant and then as a surgeon. He performed numerous procedures in the field of septic and aseptic bone and joint surgery under supervision of a consultant. He is involved in the daily ward rounds which he led himself in the last year of his employment. He is a member of the multidisciplinary treatment planning team of doctors, physiotherapists and nurses. Mr. Majed Aljudaibi gained far reaching skills and experiences in the peri- and postoperative management of patients in the field of orthopaedic and trauma surgery.

Mr. Majed Aljudaibi is a regular member of the on-call team. Here he had the opportunity to manage emergency patients including the treatment of wounds and fractures under the supervision of a consultant. He gained valuable skills regarding diagnostic and therapeutic regimen of fractures and luxations, injuries to the chest and abdomen as well as head and spinal injuries with and without neurological damage.

Mr. Majed Aljudaibi is a valuable team member and is liked by all specialities because of his always friendly but competent manner. His spoken and written German is nearly as perfect as a native speaker. He clearly gained invaluable experience in communicative skills and medical competency. A log-book of surgical procedures was checked and signed by me towards the end of his training.

This time of training in the BG Trauma Center I strongly recommend, that Mr. Aljudaibi may continue his training in trauma and orthopedic surgery.
